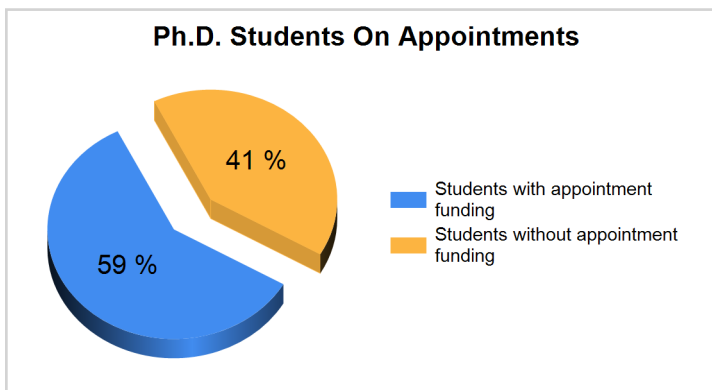

- Some departments support students from UF Foundation funds

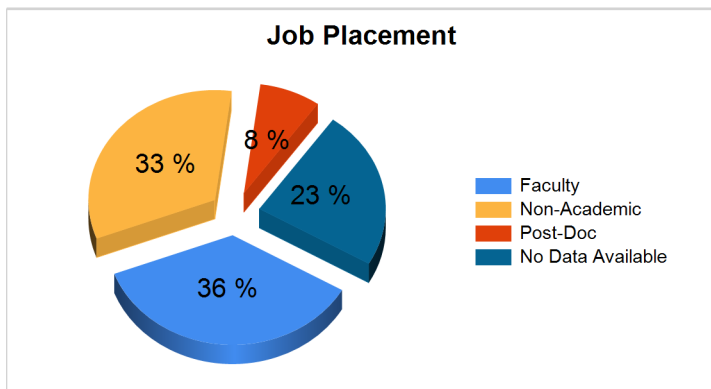

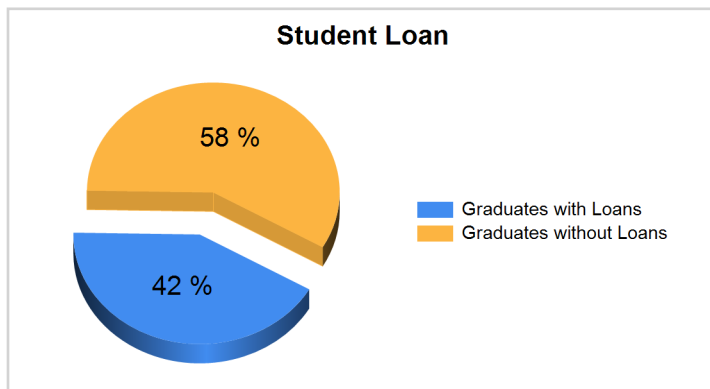
