Department Comments:

Our college includes Ph.D. students who are continuing from their master's degree in our program, so our numbers are slightly higher than what is represented.

Our college accepts a number of doctoral students who are full-time employees in the university system or have outside employers. They are part-time students, so are not eligible for appointments or funding. These students appear in the "students without appointments" data. Therefore, the percentage of non-funded students is actually much lower.
